The Maryland Department of the Environment ("MDE") has completed its review of Upper Chesapeake Medical Center's waiver request that was submitted on November 8th, 2023. Based upon this review, MDE has granted Upper Chesapeake Medical Center a waiver from Maryland's Solid Waste Management – Organics Recycling and Waste Diversion – Food Residuals regulations (COMAR 26.04.13) until **May 1, 2024**.

MDE reminds you that regulated persons are required to report on the person's solid waste and recyclable materials management activities during the preceding calendar year to each county where the solid waste and recyclable materials were generated (COMAR 26.04.13.05).

Thank you for your cooperation in providing a sound solid waste management plan to bring Upper Chesapeake Medical Center into compliance with the law.
