PETITION FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW

National Waste Managers, Inc., files Petition for Judicial Review of the November 6, 2024, determination of the Maryland Department of Environment to deny the application of a Refuse Disposal Permit for the proposed Chesapeake Terrace Rubble Landfill to be located along Patuxent Road in Odenton, Maryland.
