REPORT OF THE MARYLAND BUREAU OF MINES 1958

To His Excellency,

HON. J. MILLARD TAWES,

Governor of Maryland.

SIR:

The report herewith submitted is for the calendar year 1958 and is the Eighty-second Annual Report upon conditions of the Coal and Clay mines within the State.

The reports from the various mining operators throughout the State show the tonnage to be as follows:

COAL AND CLAY PRODUCTION

COAL PRODUCTION

ALLEGANY COUNTY: During the calendar year 1958, Allegany County mines employed 165 miners, 20 drivers (including motormen, brakemen, etc.), 22 inside laborers, and 59 outside employees, making a total of 266 men. The production of coal for 1958 was 187,713.19 net tons. This shows a production of 705 net tons per man employed during this period.

GARRETT COUNTY: During the calendar year 1958, Garrett County mines employed 215 miners, 28 drivers, (including motormen, brakemen, etc.), 33 inside laborers and 181 outside employees, making a total of 457 men. The production of coal for 1958 was 671,185.01 net tons. This shows a production of 1468 net tons per man employed during this period.

FIRE CLAY PRODUCTION

ALLEGANY COUNTY: During the calendar year 1958, the fire clay mines in Allegany County employed 27 miners, 3 drivers, 3 inside laborers and 17 outside employees, making a total of 50 men. The production of fire clay during 1958 was 48,395.12 net tons, and shows a production of 967 net tons per man.

GARRETT COUNTY: There was no clay production during the calendar year 1958. Clay operations in Garrett County ceased during March 1952, and have never resumed operations.

STRIP MINING

The Strip Mining Laws of the State of Maryland went into effect on June 1, 1955. To engage in open pit mining of bituminous coal, the operator must first file an application as provided by this department. Each application will cover four acres of coal to be stripped. This must be accompanied by a Form of Bond, Cash or U. S. Government Securities in the amount of four hundred dollars (\$400.00), one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per acre. The operator must also pay a filing fee of two hundred dollars (\$200.00). A PERMIT, giving the location of the acreage to be stripped, is then issued to the operator by the Bureau of Mines.

To further comply with this law, the operator must file an Operations Report within thirty (30) days after starting removal of overburden. Within six (6) months after the operation is finished or abandoned, the operator must file a Completion Report with the Bureau.

When the open pit mining operation is terminated and the operator has complied with all regulations set out in this law, the Director of the Bureau of Mines will issue a release of the bond, cash or securities as deposited with the State Treasurer.

KITZMILLER MINE RESCUE TEAM

The Kitzmiller Mine Rescue Team is still intact and has regular practice sessions under the supervision of Harry B. Buckley, District Mine Inspector.

The members of the team during 1958 were Captain Carl Schell, Kenneth A. Bray, Richard E. Sherwood, Haven D. Chapman, Jesse H. Reel, Frank J. Reel, William A. Hartman and Charles G. Paugh. All of the members of this team resided in the vicinity of Kitzmiller, Maryland.

The Mine Rescue Team and the Maryland Bureau of Mines cooperate with the Maryland Civil Defense Agency to provide adequate rescue service for all cases of emergency.

SAFETY ORDERS

During the calendar year 1958, there were no Safety Orders issued by the District Mine Inspectors of the Bureau of Mines.

PROSECUTIONS

There were no prosecutions due to violations of the Mining Laws, during the calendar year 1958.

FATALITIES

No fatal accidents occurred in the coal mines of Maryland during the calendar year 1958. Maryland has had no fatal mine accidents since 1953. The Operators and Employees are again to be commended for the splendid record, and it is anticipated that SAFETY CONSCIOUSNESS will continue to produce fatality free years in the future.

LABOR CONDITIONS — 1958

Labor conditions during the year 1958 were not changed to any extent, in either Garrett or Allegany Counties. There were no work stoppages reported.

Several new strip operations were started, but one of the largest producers of strip coal for the past several years discontinued operations.

ACTIVITIES OF FUEL COMBUSTION ADVISOR

For The Year 1958

During the year 1958, Mr. Robert D. Ewing, Fuel Combustion Advisor, spent 87 days in the office and laboratory at Westernport and 54 days at State Institutions. A total of 103 days were spent in the field collecting samples, advising on coal preparation, etc. One day was spent at the Garrett County Board of Education Custodian's Workshop. Mr. Ewing processed approximately 244 coal samples in the coal testing laboratory.

Several complaints were received concerning the quality of the coal received at State Institutions. Some were found to be due to high ash and moisture content of the coal. Some were operational faults; others were due to improper sizing and the ash fusion temperature of the ash being too low.

The high moisture was due to absorption of moisture in transit and improper storage at the institution.

When a complaint originated, samples of coal were collected, a complete analysis of the coal was made, the complaint investigated and corrective measures taken.

Most of the operational faults were quickly corrected. In some cases the faults of design and operation of present equipment is still under study.

After conferences with the supplier, the cases of improper sizing of the coal for the institution to which it was delivered, were corrected.

REPORT OF VOCATIONAL MINING EDUCATION

THOMAS B. POWELL, Instructor

The Night Mining Classes opened their sessions January 9, 1958, and ended May 1, 1958.

The classes were instructed by Thomas B. Powell, District Mine Inspector, assisted by District Mine Inspectors Harry B. Buckley and James H. Close.

The classes were conducted as follows:

Kitzmilller	Tuesday Night
Barton	Thursday Night
Frostburg	Friday Night

The Frostburg class was held at State Teachers College, while the class in Barton was held at the High School and the Kitzmiller class in The Community Building.

The Kitzmiller class had an enrollment of 16 students; the Frostburg class 36 students and the Barton class had 12 students.

The subjects studied were:

- Supervision of Personnel
- Mine Gases and Gas Testing
- Mine Ventilation
- Electricity
- The Use of permissible explosives
- Flame Safety Lamps
- Map Reading
- Mining Methods
- Mine Fires and Explosions

The classes met weekly and averaged two or more hours each. Much interest was shown in these classes, and perhaps the most important part of each class session was the student participation period. At this time, each student contributed by asking questions pertaining to mining problems and by giving others the benefit of his experiences with pertinent mining issues.

CONCLUSION

With the continued improvements in the coal industry, enough interest was displayed in Vocational Mining to carry on this program and demonstrated the continued need for this type of training.
