The Maryland Department of the Environment, Air and Radiation Administration (ARA) received a permit-to-construct application from Excalibur Site Services, LLC on February 15, 2022 for the installation of two (2) crushing and screening plants, each rated at 300 tons per hour, and each equipped with up to three diesel engines, processing waste asphalt pavement, waste concrete, brick, block, and other building demolition materials. The proposed installation will be located at 5301 Andard Street, Baltimore, MD 21226.
