**NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND INFORMATIONAL MEETING**

The Maryland Department of the Environment, Air and Radiation Administration (ARA) received a permit-to-construct application from Talbot County Repurposing Center on June 15, 2022 for the installation of one (1) 200 ton per hour Rubble Master Impact Crusher powered by one 225 horsepower diesel engine. The proposed installation will be located at 28128 St. Michaels Rd., Easton, MD 21601.

An Informational Meeting will be held on Thursday, November 3, 2022 at 5:30 PM at the Talbot County Parks & Recreation Community Center, Wye Oak Room, located at 10028 Ocean Gateway in Easton, MD 210601.

Pursuant to the Environment Article, Section 1-603, Annotated Code of Maryland, the Informational Meeting has been scheduled so that citizens can discuss the application and the permit review process with the applicant and the Department.
