Application for State Discharge Permit 24DP2937, NPDES Permit MD0066079:

AES Warrior Run Limited Partnership, 11600 Mexico Farms Road, S.E., Cumberland, MD 21502 submitted an application for renewal of a permit to discharge an average of 146,000 gallons per day of cooling tower blowdown, boiler blowdown, demineralizer regeneration wastewater, and carbon dioxide scrubber wastes and variable volumes of stormwater, including coal pile runoff, from a steam electric cogeneration and carbon dioxide production facility, located at 11600 Mexico Farms Road, SE, Cumberland, MD to the North Branch Potomac River (Use I-P waters).

This facility is located on a census tract with an Environmental Justice (EJ) Score in the 60th percentile of all tracts in Maryland. This EJ score has been calculated considering a combination of the following factors: pollution burden exposure, pollution burden environmental effects, sensitive populations, and socioeconomic indicators (https://mdewwp.page.link/EJ).
