## Application for State Discharge Permit 25DP0422, NPDES Permit MD0001384:

Congoleum Corporation, 2700 Emory Rd., Finksburg, MD 21048 submitted an application for renewal of a permit to discharge an average of 147,000 gallons per day of process wastewater, 1,200 gallons per day of sanitary wastewater, and variable volumes of stormwater from a facility which manufactures flooring felt, located at 2700 Emory Rd., Finksburg, MD, to the North Branch Patapsco River (Use IV-P waters).

This facility is located on a census tract with an Environmental Justice (EJ) Score in the 19th percentile of all tracts in Maryland. This EJ score has been calculated considering a combination of the following factors: pollution burden exposure, pollution burden environmental effects, sensitive populations, and socioeconomic indicators (https://mdewwp.page.link/EJ).
