Application for State Discharge Permit 26DP1841, NPDES Permit MD0058611:

Trans-Tech, Inc., 5520 Adamstown Rd., Adamstown, MD 21710, submitted an application for renewal of a permit to discharge an average of 2,085 gallons per day of process wastewater, an average of 445 gallons per day of sanitary wastewater, and variable volumes of stormwater from a facility that manufactures ceramic electronic components, located at 5520 Adamstown Rd., Adamstown, MD to Tuscarora Creek (Use I-P waters).

Per MD Environmental Article § 1-602(a)(2), an EJ score was calculated for this facility. The EJ Score is 56.60. This score has been calculated considering a combination of the following factors: Pollution Burden Exposure Percentile, Pollution Burden Environmental Effects Percentile, and Sensitive Population Percentile.
