Follow these tips to make this winter easier, safer, and healthier for both your community and watershed.



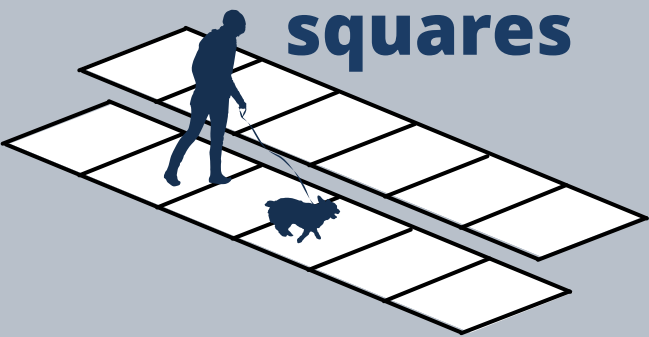
SHOVEL EARLY, SHOVEL WELL

Removing snow before ice has the chance to form is the best way to stay on top of winter maintenance.

10 sidewalk squares

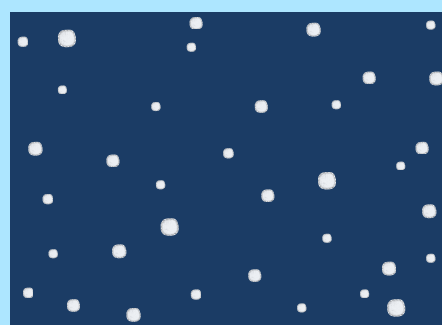


A LITTLE GOES A LONG WAY

In order for salt to be effective as a deicer, it's important to measure the right amount for the surface you need to cover.

SPREAD EVENLY

Avoid clumps of salt. Apply salt in an even spread so that granules are at least 1-2 inches away from each other.



IT ONLY TAKES ONE TEASPOON OF SALT TO POLLUTE FIVE GALLONS OF WATER, AND ONCE IT ENTERS THE GROUND OR SURFACE WATER, IT NEVER GOES AWAY. LETS REDUCE OUR IMPACT AT THE SOURCE.

1 teaspoon

=

5 gallons
polluted water
