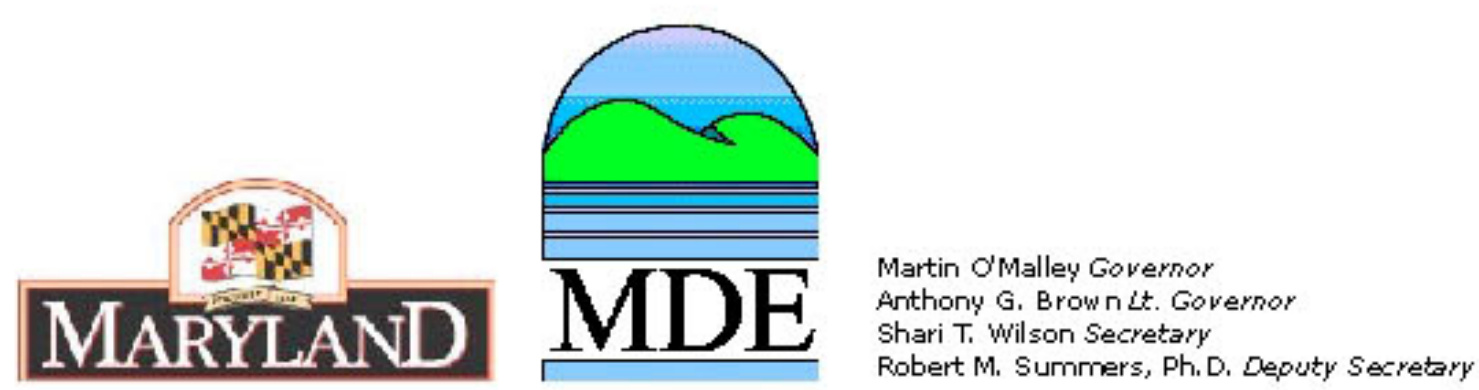


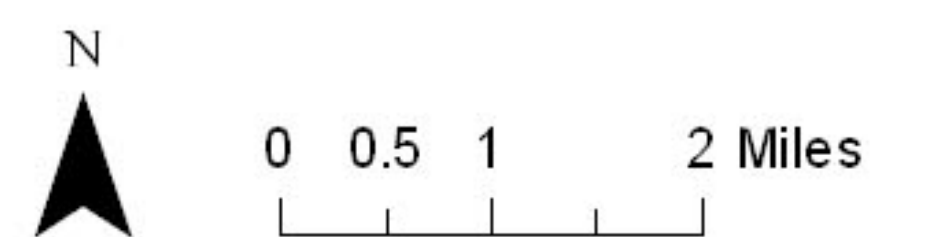
Priority Sites for Wetland Restoration for Diversity in Harford County
