Description: AARON M. HOLDER, 20704 Sinning Wheel Place, Germantown, Maryland 20874, has applied after the fact for impacts associated with construction of a new driveway. The project permanently impacted 200 square feet of forested nontidal wetland, and 615 square feet of 25-foot nontidal wetland buffer. The project is adjacent to Unnamed Tributary to Bear Branch (USE III-P stream). Mitigation will be required at a 2:1 mitigation to impact ratio for all permanent nontidal wetland impacts. The applicant proposes to purchase wetland mitigation credit from the Even Flow Mitigation Bank or another approved mitigation bank. The project is located on Mount Ephraim Road adjacent to 1721 Mount Ephraim Road, Adamstown, Maryland 21710.
