- 🚴 Stimulate local economic growth



NEED:


- 🚴 Lack of a Safe, Continuous, Accessible Route

PROJECT OVERVIEW- ENTIRE CORRIDOR


- 🚲 Total Length of Bike Path = 12.4 Miles
- 🚲 **Phase 1** = 4.6 Miles (Completed Construction)
- 🚲 **Phase 2 (A/B)** = 4.61 Miles (Current Project)
- 🚲 **Phase 2C** = 3.2 Miles (Under Construction)
