This mitigation bank would provide compensatory mitigation for future nontidal wetland impacts authorized by the Maryland Department of the Environment in the USGS 8-digit hydrologic unit code (HUC) of Tangier (HUC 02080110), Nanticoke (HUC 02080109), Pocomoke-Western Lower Delmarva (HUC 02080111), and Choptank (HUC 02060005). The proposed mitigation project includes grading and planting that would result in approximately 38.5 acres of wetland re-establishment, 10.6 acres of wetland rehabilitation, 97.3 acres of wetland enhancement, 44.4 acres of wetland preservation, 49.6 acres of upland restoration and 3.3 acres of upland preservation.
