# **SPECIAL CONDITIONS**

A. The terms and conditions of Tidal Wetlands License No. 19-WL-0460 are hereby incorporated, by reference, into this Water Quality Certification. The Certification Holder shall comply with these conditions to ensure that the authorized activities will not result in a violation of the State's water quality standards.

# **GENERAL CONDITIONS**

- A. The proposed project shall be constructed in a manner which will not violate Maryland's Water Quality Standards as set forth in COMAR 26.08.02. The applicant is to notify this Department ten (10) days prior to commencing work. Verbal notification is to be followed by written notice within ten (10) days.
- B. The Maryland Department of the Environment has determined that the proposed activities comply with, and will be conducted in a manner consistent with the State's Coastal Zone Management Program, as required by Section 307 of the Federal Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972, as amended.
- C. If the authorized work is not performed by the property owner, all work performed under this Tidal Wetlands License shall be conducted by a marine contractor licensed by the Marine Contractors Licensing Board (MCLB) in accordance with Title 17 of the Environment Article of Annotated Code of Maryland. A list of licensed marine contractors may be obtained by contacting the MCLB at 410-537-3249, by e-mail at MDE.MCLB@maryland.gov or by accessing the Maryland Department of the Environment, Environmental Boards webpage.
- D. The Certification Holder shall ensure the proposed project shall be constructed in accordance with the authorized plan and any authorized revisions.
- E. The Certification Holder shall ensure that all fill and construction materials not used in the project shall be removed and disposed of in a manner which will prevent their entry into waters of this State.
- F. The Certification Holder shall notify the Water and Science Administration, Tidal Wetlands Division, in writing, upon transferring property ownership or responsibility for compliance with these conditions to another person. The new owner/operator shall request, in writing, transfer of this Water Quality Certification to his/her name.
- G. The Certification Holder shall allow representatives of the Maryland Department of the Environment to inspect the authorized activities.
- H. The Certification Holder shall ensure that a copy of this Permit, including the approved plans, is available at the site until the authorized work is complete.
- I. The Certification does not relieve the Certification holder from the responsibility of obtaining all necessary federal, State, and local government authorizations.
- J. The Certification Holder shall comply with all Critical Area requirements and obtain all necessary authorizations from local jurisdiction. This Certification does not constitute authorization for disturbance in the 100-foot Critical Area Buffer. "Disturbance" in the Buffer means clearing, grading, construction activities, or removal of any size of tree or vegetation. Any anticipated Buffer disturbance requires prior written approval, before commencement of land disturbing activity, from local jurisdiction in the form of a Buffer Management Plan.

Failure to comply with these conditions shall constitute reason for suspension or revocation of the Water Quality Certification, and legal proceedings may be instituted against the Certification Holder in accordance with the Annotated Code of Maryland. In granting this certification, the Department reserves the right to inspect the operations and records regarding this project at anytime

### WETLANDS LICENSE NO. 19-0460

## **QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY** DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION

The Maryland Board of Public Works authorizes you to:

- I. Mechanically or hydraulically maintenance dredge a 5,243-foot long by 50 to 106-foot wide channel to a depth of -5.0 feet at mean low water (MLW).
- II. Mechanically or hydraulically dredge a 155-foot long by 178-foot wide area of new dredging to a depth of -3.0 feet at MLW.
- Deposit approximately 21,217 cubic yards of material at an approved upland disposal site III. located at 421 Watson Road, Centreville, Maryland.
- Provide for periodic maintenance dredging for six years. IV.
- Collect four sediment cores at a depth of -6.0 feet at MLW. V.

Corsica River, Centreville, Queen Anne's County, Maryland

Issuance of this Tidal Wetlands License constitutes the State's determination that the authorized activities are consistent with the Maryland Coastal Zone Management Program, as required by Section 307 of the Federal Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972, as amended [16 U.S.C. §1456]. Accordingly, the State concurs with the Licensee's certification in the Joint Permit Application that the project complies with, and will be conducted in a manner consistent with the Maryland CZMP.

### THIS LICENSE AUTHORIZES YOU TO PERFORM THE WORK ONLY IF YOU COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING SPECIAL CONDITION(S):

- A. To minimize impacts to spawning anadromous and resident fish species, no dredging, regardless of method, shall be conducted from February 15 through June 15 of any year.
- B. Licensee shall conduct subsequent maintenance dredging within the scope of this license in terms of authorized dredge area and authorized depths. Licensee shall:
  - a. Dredge no more than 500 cubic yards of material at each maintenance dredging.
  - b. Comply with all applicable conditions of this license.
  - c. Submit a detailed dredged material disposal plan to be approved by Maryland Department of the Environment's (MDE) Water and Science Administration, Tidal Wetlands Division, prior to the start of dredging.

- d. Notify and receive approval from MDE's Water and Science Administration, Compliance Program, a minimum of 10 days prior to the start of each maintenance dredging operation.
- C. Licensee shall stake the dredge area and receive approval from MDE's Water and Science Administration's Compliance Division prior to the start of dredging.
- D. Licensee shall conduct a post dredge bathymetric survey and forward to MDE's Water and Science Administration, Tidal Wetlands Division, within 45 days after the termination of any phase of dredging.
- E. Before work begins, Licensee must have an MDE-approved Dredge Material Disposal Plan.
- F. Licensee may dispose of dredged material only at an MDE-approved dredge disposal site.

#### MECHANICAL DREDGING SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

- G. Licensee shall transport all dredged material in watertight trucks. No dredged material shall be discharged onto the roadways of the State.
- H. After initial maintenance dredging, Licensee may perform subsequent maintenance dredging that adheres to the same standards as the initial maintenance dredging.
- I. Licensee may not dredge more than 500 cubic yards of material during any subsequent maintenance dredging operation.

#### HYDRAULIC DREDGING SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

- J. If hydraulic dredging is performed, the dredged material placement site (DMP) shall be constructed to limit turbidity in the discharge to waters of the State. A turbidity sample of the discharge water shall be performed every hour of active pumping to the DMP or when there is an observed change in the clarity of the water. Turbidity in the discharge may not exceed 150 units at any time or 50 units as a monthly average. Units shall be measured in Nephelometer Turbidity Units. A logbook of all turbidity monitoring shall be kept on site. The dredger shall have a person at the discharge point of the DMP in constant radio communication. If a problem is incurred, the dredging operation shall be immediately shutdown until the reason for the problem can be ascertained and rectified.
- K. The dredge operator shall have a person at the discharge point of the DMP in constant radio communication. If a problem is incurred, the dredging operation shall be immediately shut down until the reason for the problem can be ascertained and rectified. MDE compliance shall be notified.

# THIS LICENSE AUTHORIZES YOU TO PERFORM THE WORK ONLY IF YOU COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING STANDARD CONDITIONS:

- Licensee shall conduct the authorized work in accordance with the plans and drawings dated November 2019, which are hereby incorporated into this License.
   Until the authorized work is complete, Licensee shall have available at the site a copy of this License including the plans and drawings.
- 2. This License constitutes Maryland's authorization to conduct the authorized work under the State Tidal Wetlands Law. This License does not bestow any other federal, State, or local government authorization.

- 3. Licensee shall have all proposed work above Mean High Water reviewed and authorized by the local county Department of Planning and Zoning or applicable agency.
- 4. Licensee shall notify MDE's Inspection and Compliance Program by phone (410-537-3510) AND in writing (MDE, Inspection and Compliance Program, 1800 Washington Boulevard, Baltimore, MD 21230) of the following:
  - start date at least five business days before beginning work; and
  - completion date no more than five business days after project completion.
- 5. If MDE has issued a Water Quality Certification with respect to the authorized work, Licensee shall comply with all conditions of that certification.

6. Licensee shall conduct the authorized work in accordance with Critical Area Commission

- requirements. This License does not authorize disturbance in the Buffer. If authorized work will disturb the Buffer, Licensee shall have a Commission-approved or locally-approved Buffer Management Plan before beginning the authorized work.

  "Buffer" means the 100-foot Critical Area Buffer and any expanded area that is immediately landward of the mean high water line of the tidal waters or is immediately landward of tidal wetlands. The Buffer includes expanded contiguous area if the contiguous area includes steep slopes, hydric soil, or highly erodible soil, or otherwise meets the criteria of COMAR 27.01.09.01.E(7). "Disturbance" means any alteration or change to the land including any amount of clearing. Clearing includes vegetation removal, grading, and construction activity.
- 7. Licensee may not fill, dredge, or otherwise alter or destroy tidal marsh or its vegetation unless this License specifically authorizes the activity.
- 8. Licensee may not stockpile material in State tidal wetlands or State tidal waters of the U.S.
- 9. Licensee shall allow unfettered public use of State wetlands and State tidal waters of the U.S.
- 10. This License does not transfer a property interest of the State.
- 11. Licensee shall file a Miss Utility ticket for the proposed work at least 10 days before beginning work. Miss Utility: 800-257-7777
- 12. Licensee shall ensure that structures (for example, piers and piles) removed from the site are taken to an upland disposal facility approved by MDE's Inspection and Compliance Program.
- 13. If the authorized work impacts more than 5,000 square feet or includes 100 or more cubic yards of fill, Licensee shall conduct the authorized work in accordance with a locally-approved Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Plan.
- 14. If the authorized work is not performed by the property owner, all work performed under this Tidal Wetlands License shall be conducted by a marine contractor licensed by the Marine Contractors Licensing Board (MCLB) in accordance with Title 17 of the Environment Article of Annotated Code of Maryland. A list of licensed marine contactors may be obtained by contacting the MCLB at 410-537-3249, by email at MDE.MCLB@maryland.gov or by accessing the Maryland Department of the Environment, Environmental Boards webpage.
- 15. Licensee shall allow State officials and employees to make inspections at reasonable times and cooperate with those inspections.
- 16. This License is granted only to the Licensee. Licensee may transfer the license only with written approval from the Board of Public Works. If the Board of Public Works approves the transfer, the transferee is subject to all License terms and conditions.

- 17. Licensee shall indemnify, defend, and save harmless the State of Maryland, its officials, officers, and employees from and against any and all liability, suits, claims, and actions of whatever kind, caused by or arising from, the work this License authorizes.
- 18. The Board of Public Works or its Wetlands Administrator may modify, suspend, or revoke this License in its reasonable discretion.
- 19. This License expires January 8, 2023. If the authorized work is not completed by the expiration date, all activity must stop.

NOTE: A three-year license may be renewed for one additional three-year term if the Licensee requests an extension before the expiration date and all other conditions are met. A six-year license may not be renewed; instead Licensee must reapply to MDE for a new license. Contact the Board of Public Works to determine if this License may be extended. 
HYDRAULIC PIPELINE PLAN






