ii Please submit a location map and plan of the proposed subdivision for MDE review. MDE will determine whether a permit is required, or a Notice of Exemption may be filed and will notify you if a permit application is required.

ⁱⁱⁱ Year-round resident means an individual whose primary residence is served by the water system. The individual need not live at the residence 365 days a year for it to be considered their year-round residence.
