**County: Queen Annes**

QA2023G001/01: Brian Short has applied to appropriate and use an annual average of 55,200 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 335,700 gpd in the month of maximum use. Water will be withdrawn from a pond excavated in the Columbia aquifer and used for crop irrigation. The project is located on the east side of Dudley Corners Road, approximately half mile north of its junction with Maryland Route 301 and seven miles southwest of Millington, Queen Anne's County, Maryland.

**County: Wicomico**

WI2023G003/01: Fred R. Moore & Son, Inc. has applied to appropriate and use an annual average of 325,000 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 1,977,700 gpd in the month of maximum use. Water will be withdrawn from five wells in the Manokin aquifer and used for sod irrigation and/or crop irrigation. The project is located at 25507 Collins Wharf Rd, Eden, Wicomico County, Maryland.
