## County: Dorchester

DO1998G002/04: Robert Howard has applied to increase an existing allocation from an annual average of 33,000 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 198,000 gpd during the month of maximum use, to an annual average of 66,000 gpd and an average of 403,000 gpd during the month of maximum use for crop irrigation. Water will be withdrawn from two wells in the Columbia aquifer. The project is located at 6824 Whitely Road, Federalsburg, Dorchester County, Maryland.

## County: Worcester

WO1998G024/03: Murray Brothers has applied to increase an existing allocation from an annual average of 160,000 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 970,000 (gpd) during the month of maximum use, to an annual average of 207,000 gpd and an average of 1,255,000 gpd during the month of maximum use for crop and sod irrigation. Water will be withdrawn from one well in the Pocomoke aquifer. The project is located on Tull Road, 0.1 mile south of its junction with Ebenezer Road, one mile north of Maryland Route 610, Whaleyville, Worcester County, Maryland.
