## County: Baltimore City

BC2023G004/01: Baltimore Gas & Electric Company has applied to to appropriate and use an annual average of 18,800 gallons of water per day (gpd) and an average of 76,300 gpd in the month of maximum use. The water will be withdrawn from up to 110 well points in the Lowland Deposits to lower the aquifer water level for construction of a new building and electrical substation. The project is located at 2804 Clare Street, Baltimore City, Maryland.

## **County: Dorchester**

DO2024G001/01: High Probability, LLC has applied to appropriate and use an annual average of 77,000 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 330,000 gpd during the month of maximum use for crop irrigation and filling duck ponds. Water will be withdrawn from two new wells in the Piney Point aquifer. The project is located immediately southwest of the junction of Golden Hill Road and Blackwater Road, Church Creek, Dorchester County, Maryland.
