BC2024G002/01: Amtrak Northeast Corridor (NEC) has applied to appropriate and use an annual average of 75,000 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 150,000 gpd in the month of maximum use. The water will be withdrawn from twelve well points in the James Run Gneiss formation to facilitate the construction of the Frederick Douglas utility tunnel. The project is located between Spedden Street and North Payson Street, and between Edmondson Ave and W. Lafayette Ave., Baltimore City, Maryland.

CO2024G009/01: G. Arthur Steward and George Steward have applied to appropriate and use an annual average of 130,000 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and a maximum monthly use of 790,000 gpd from four wells in the Columbia aquifer for crop irrigation. The project is located at 11665 Knife Box Road, Greensboro, Caroline County, Maryland.

CO2024G011/01: Norris Hayman has applied to appropriate and use an annual average of 67,000 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 407,000 gpd during the month of maximum use for crop irrigation. Water will be withdrawn from two wells in the Columbia aquifer. The project is located at 15069 Drapers Mill Road, Goldsboro, Caroline County, Maryland.
