County: Baltimore

BA2026G003/01: Whitelyn Farms, Inc. has applied to appropriate and use 20,400 gallons per day (gpd) annual average and 30,600 gpd in the month of maximum use (MMU). The water will come from two new and three existing wells in the Hydes Marble Formation of the Loch Raven Schist. The water will be used for a dairy operation. The project is located at 5101 Hydes Road, Hydes, Baltimore County, Maryland.

County: Baltimore City

BC2026G001/01: Amtrak has applied to appropriate and use an annual average of 22,200 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 34,300 gpd in the month of maximum use to temporarily lower groundwater levels to facilitate construction during the installation of two new tunnels for the Amtrak Northeast tunnel project. The water will be withdrawn from a sump at the bottom of an excavation in the James Run Formation. The project is located at Amtrak Right-of-Way and I-83 ROW near 340 North Avenue, City of Baltimore, Maryland.

County: Talbot

TA1971G005/07: Easton Utilities Commission has applied to maintain the existing appropriation of an annual average of 1,000,000 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 2,000,000 (gpd) during the month of maximum use for the Town of Easton community water system. Water will be withdrawn from three existing wells and one new well, all in the Magothy aquifer. The existing wells are located at 219 North Washington Street (#6), 7891 Ocean Gateway (#7), and 29105 Airpark Drive (#8). The new well is located 0.05 mile west of Tristan Drive (#14), Easton, Talbot County, Maryland.

County: Washington

WA1988G032/09: Washington County Department Of Water Quality has applied to increase an existing allocation from an annual average of 100,000 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 150,000 gpd during the month of maximum use, to an annual average of 150,000 gpd and an average of 250,000 gpd during the month of maximum use for the public water supply for the Highfield and Cascade Town Center water systems. Water will be withdrawn from three wells in the Catoctin Metabasalt. The project is located 0.2 Mile southwest of Pennersville and Highfield Roads, on the east corner of Springdale and Cascade Roads, 0.1 mile south of Highfield and Cascade Roads, 0.1 mile southwest of Water Company and Hilltop Roads, Cascade, Washington County, Maryland.

WI2026G001/01: Justin Day has applied to appropriate and use an annual average of 37,000 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and 223,000 gpd during the month of maximum use for crop irrigation. Water will be withdrawn from one well in the Columbia aquifer. The project is located on the west side of Rounds Road, 0.1 mile north of West Street, Wicomico County, Maryland.
