CO2004G014/05: Noble Kelley, Jr. has applied to increase an existing water appropriation from an annual average of 66,000 gallons of groundwater per day (gpd) and an average of 401,000 gpd during the month of maximum use to an annual average of 100,500 gpd and 611,000 gpd during the month of maximum use for crop irrigation. Water will be withdrawn from three existing wells and four new wells, all in the Columbia aquifer. The project is located at 22152 Dover Bridge Road, Preston, Caroline County, Maryland.

QA2022S001/01: Jeffery Barnett Clark has applied to appropriate and use an annual average of 50,000 gallons of water per day (gpd) and a maximum day use of 336,000 gallons.
