## WATER AUDITS and LOSS REDUCTION REPORT 2013

Water audits are conducted to determine the amount of water lost from a distribution system due to leakage. A comprehensive audit can provide the water system with a detailed profile of the distribution system and the water uses allowing for more effective management of the resource and infrastructure.

Water audits are usually required for water systems serving greater than 10,000 people and are required as a condition of the water system's Water Appropriation and Use Permit. Audits are completed annually and report on the previous year's water production. Any reported water loss greater than 10% triggers submission of a water loss reduction plan.

The State of Maryland has 31 water systems serving a population greater than 10,000 people. For calendar year 2013, 28 of these systems completed an audit and 61% of the systems reported water loss below 10%, while 39% reported more than 10% water loss.
