Dear Mr. Hunt:

The Maryland Department of the Environment, Water and Science Administration, Wastewater Pollution Prevention and Reclamation Program (Department) has received correspondence from Craig Schriener, on behalf of Days Cove Reclamation Company, dated May 21, 2026, which requests termination of State Discharge Permit No. 19-DP-3782 (Permit).

Pursuant to 40 CFR §122.64(b), the Department may terminate an NPDES permit via notice to the permittee if the entire discharge is permanently terminated and there are no pending State or Federal actions. The procedures in this part specify a 30-day period for potential objections from the permittee. **As a result, this letter formally terminates coverage under State Discharge Permit 19-DP-3782 (NPDES Number MD0071587) as of June 25, 2026.** Should you wish to object to this termination, you must submit such a notice to Joey Dickson (joey.dickson@maryland.gov), by 5 p.m. on June 25, 2026. Such notification should be provided via email attachment.
